Cut and Paste Christianity (Part 2)

Lies, Deceits, Falsehoods

For the past year or so, I have avoided the evening news, both local, Fox and any other sources of hype that is being spewed out on the airwaves. The discussion was on the US Archives placing a warning on several documents in their catalogue. I thought "you've got to be kidding me!" The documents included; The US Constitution, The Declaration of Independence and the Bill of Rights.

They're softening of the warning is that they mention no specific document but it is a blanket statement. I verified it on line through Snopes.

The following is the two pertinent paragraphs contained in the warning: "The Catalog and web pages contain some content that may be harmful or difficult to view. NARA's records span the history of the United States, and it is our charge to preserve and make available these historical records. As a result, some of the materials presented here may reflect outdated, biased, offensive, and possibly violent views and opinions. In addition, some of the materials may relate to violent or graphic events and are preserved for their historical significance. Such content includes items that may reflect <u>racist</u>, <u>sexist</u>, <u>or xenophobic</u> opinions or be discriminatory against views on sexuality, gender, and religion. Other items include graphic descriptions of historical events like a violent death, medical procedures, crime, acts of war or terrorism, and natural disasters. WOW! The Constitution and Declaration of Independence offensive?! Offensive to who!? Only to those supporting a divisive, anti-American agenda, the "Alphabet

Perverts" and race baiters. This was the first eye catcher although "jaw dropper" may be fitting.

The second one was just as absurd as the first. Merriam-Webster actually changed the definition of vaccine this past spring. With all the propaganda and the push for vaccine mandates this wasn't really surprising. The following is from The Red Elephant.com:

Merriam-Webster Dictionary Quietly Changes Definition of 'Vaccine' to Include

COVID-19 mRNA Injection

March 2, 2021- Merriam-Webster dictionary has quietly changed the definition of the term 'vaccine' to include components of the COVID-19 mRNA injection. The definition of vaccine was specifically changed due to the COVID-19 injection. The definition of 'vaccine' as of February 5th 2021: vaccine [vak'sēn]

NOUN- a substance used to stimulate the production of antibodies and provide immunity against one or several diseases, prepared from the causative agent of a disease, its products, or a synthetic substitute, treated to act as an antigen without inducing the disease.

The *former* definition of vaccine: A vaccine used to be "a preparation of killed microorganisms, living attenuated organisms, or living fully virulent organisms that is administered to produce or artificially increase *immunity* to a particular

disease", meaning it had nothing to do with mRNA injections, which are not live vaccines and do not use an infectious element. This one definitely tightened my jaw as well.
