Prep for Persecution

Does anyone believe that Christians are being persecuted here in the United States? We know full well they are being kidnapped and murdered in some of the Muslim counties around the world, but are they truly being persecuted here in the Land of the Free and Home of the Brave? You bet we are.

The "creeping incrementalism" we have spoken of has gained more ground in the past decade or so since the Obama administration. Remember, how the Department of Health and Human Services persecuted a Christian Charity, Little Sisters of the Poor, because they refused to pay for abortion inducing drugs based on their religious beliefs? They finally won after several years of litigation and a Supreme Court decision in their favor. Such a legacy for a President to leave behind, an unearned Nobel and gender-neutral bathrooms. There was another coach, Joe Kennedy, from Bremerton High School in Washington that was also fired for praying at a football game. The Supreme Court ruled that "a government entity sought to punish an individual for engaging in a brief, quiet, personal religious observance doubly protected by the Free Exercise and Free Speech Clauses of the First Amendment...the Constitution neither mandates nor tolerates that kind of discrimination. He later won a \$2 million dollar law suit.

Society may call this "discrimination" but it is persecution none the less. Is there a difference between discrimination and persecution?

Discrimination is defined by Dictionary. Com as: "an act or instance of discriminating, or of making a distinction. treatment or consideration of, or making a distinction in favor of or against, a person or thing based on the group, class, or category to which that person or thing belongs rather than on individual merit."

Whereas Persecution is defined as: "the act of <u>persecuting</u>, the state of being <u>persecuted</u>. a program or campaign to <u>exterminate</u>, <u>drive away</u>, <u>or subjugate</u> <u>people based on their membership in a religious</u>, ethnic, social, or racial group." A somewhat harsher treatment than merely discriminating.

Persecution against Christians because of their faith in Jesus Christ and love of God is certainly nothing new. Christ told us of this behavior before He was crucified.

John15:18-21- "If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love its own. However, because you are not of the world, but I have personally chosen you out of the world, the world hates you for this. Remember the world that I spoke to you: a servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted Me, they will persecute you also. If they

kept My word, they will keep your word also. But they will do all these things to you for My name's sake, because they do not know Him Who sent Me."

How many of us experienced some form of discrimination when we began to keep the Sabbath and Holy Days? Maybe we were not persecuted but we were probably singled out as an "oddball." The persecutions will undoubtedly increase as the world continues to slide into the abyss of moral decay, especially here in the U.S. where we "profess" to be a Christian Nation.

Look at the abominations that are rampant within our own nation. Flagrantly spitting in the Face of God with their perversions; homosexuality, gay marriage, sex with children, gender reassignment, abortions, transvestites, just to name a few. **Leviticus 18:22-25** "You shall not lie with mankind as with womankind. Galatians 5:1- "Therefore, stand fast in the liberty wherewith Christ has made us free, and do not be held again in a yoke of bondage."

Philippians 4:1- "Therefore, my brethren, beloved and longed for, my joy and *my* crown, stand fast in *the* Lord, beloved."

1 Thessalonians 3:7-8- "Through this *report* about you we were encouraged, brethren, in all our persecution and trouble—because of your faith; For now we live, if you stand firm in *the* Lord."

We have courage and strength in The Lord. God has not given us a spirit of fear.

1 Corinthians 16:13- "Be watchful; stand fast in the faith; conduct yourselves with courage. Be strong *in the Lord*."

2 Timothy 1:7- "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, and of love, and of sound mindedness."

We may be chastised, criticized or even arrested someday but we need not fear and we must stand our ground.

Hebrews 12:11- "Now truly, no chastisement for the present seems to be joyous, but grievous; nevertheless, afterwards it yields *the* peaceable fruits of righteousness to those who have been exercised by it."

James 1:12- "Blessed *is the* man who endures trials because, after he has been proved, he shall receive a crown of life, which the Lord has promised to those who love Him."

Revelation 2:25-26- "But hold fast what you have until I come. And to the one who overcomes, and keeps My works unto *the* end, I will give authority over the nations;"

Revelation 3:11- "Behold, I am coming quickly; hold fast that which you have so that no one may take away your crown."

Standing fast in our faith and growing ever closer to God is the foundation to build up our resources to face the impending storms. There are a few additional scriptures we need to follow that may seem even more difficult.

Pray for our enemies. Pray for those who persecute us.

Matthew 5:44- "But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who despitefully use you and persecute you," As difficult as this is, we must have a strong prayer life and forgive those who mistreat us. Jesus forgave those who crucified Him from the cross.

We must pray for our nation and its leaders. WOW! This one is a tough one. I am sure we would rather pray **Psalm 109** for most of them as we would all like to see the justice of God fall on those who pervert our way of life. But their judgment will come.

Proverbs 29:16- "When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increases; but the righteous shall see their fall."

God would rather have them come to repentance.

1 Timothy 2:2-4- "For kings and all who are in authority, in order that we may lead a quiet and peaceful life in all godliness and respectability. For this *is* good and acceptable before God our Savior, Who desires all men to be saved and to come to *the* knowledge of *the* truth."

We can no longer keep our heads buried in the sand.

Matthew 10:16- "Behold, I am sending you forth as sheep in *the* midst of wolves. Therefore, be wise as serpents and harmless as doves." We must be bold when the time comes to speak up. Complacency is how we got here in the first place. We must not conform ourselves to this world.

Romans 12:2- "Do not conform yourselves to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind in order that you may prove what is well pleasing and good, and the perfect will of God."

Galatians 1:8-9- "But if we, or even an angel from heaven, should preach a gospel to you *that* is contrary to what we have preached, LET HIM BE ACCURSED! As we have said before, I also now say again. If anyone is preaching a gospel contrary to what you have received, LET HIM BE ACCURSED!"

We have God on our side. We must trust in Him in all things. We need not fear man or his perversions.

Psalm 118:6- "The LORD is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

All of this that is taking place comes as no surprise.

Matthew 24:3-13- "And as He was sitting on the Mount of Olives, His disciples came to Him alone, saying, "Tell us, when shall these things be? And what shall be the sign of Your coming, and of the completion of the age?" Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Be on guard, so that no one deceives you. For many shall come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ'; and they shall deceive many.

And you shall hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you do not let these things disturb you. For it is necessary that all these things take place, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; and there shall be famines and pestilences and earthquakes in different places. Now all these things are the beginning of sorrows. Then shall they deliver you up to

affliction, and shall kill you; and you shall be hated by all nations for My name's sake. And then shall many be led into sin, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another; And many false prophets shall arise, and shall deceive many; And because lawlessness shall be multiplied, the love of many shall grow cold.

But the one who endures to the end, that one shall be saved."

1 Timothy 4:1-2- "Now the Spirit tells us explicitly that in the latter times some shall apostatize from the faith, and shall follow deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons; Speaking lies in hypocrisy, their consciences having been cauterized with a hot iron;"

God has equipped us with the spiritual weaponry of His word to combat the wiles of the enemy.

Ephesians 6:11-18- "Put on the whole armor of God so that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil Because we are not wrestling against flesh and blood, but against principalities *and* against powers, against the world rulers of the darkness of this age, against the spiritual *power* of wickedness in high *places*.

Therefore, take up the whole armor of God so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having worked out all things, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girded about with truth, and wearing the breastplate of righteousness, And having your feet shod with *the* preparation of the gospel of peace. Besides all

these, take up the shield of the faith, with which you will have the power to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one; And put on the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God; Praying at all times with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and in this very thing being watchful with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints;"

We are in a war. But keep in mind the victory has already been won. We still must remain on high alert as the enemy is treacherous and will target the weak and unprepared. Seeing scripture come to fruition should strengthen our resolve and motivate us to grow ever closer to our God through prayer, Bible study, and fasting. We are not blazing any new trails as so many in the Bible have faced far more difficult trials, tests, and sacrifices. We have not been fed to the lions yet, nor scourged, or crucified. We have been spared and we have not heard the sound of Jack Boots in the night. Our faith in God and His way of life are being challenged at an ever increasing and alarming rate.
