Lesson 4	Read & understand the meaning of specific Psalms & how they can draw close to God. Focus on Psalm 8. This Psalm highlights God's magnificent creation, including man. David is exulting God for His creation.	Remind children that the Psalms will help them learn how to stay close to God. Read all of Psalm 5 together. Highlight Psalm 8:5. Review Psalm 8 by cutting & pasting images for missing words in the Psalm. Talk about these things God has made as you cut and paste them. Remind children of creation & have them help you make a list of things outside that God created. Then devise a short scavenger hunt to engage them with creation outside. Thank God together for everything you find.
