In thinking back to the Kennedy assassination, I was in the second grade and was walking home from elementary school. When I got home from school, my mom was crying and both she and my dad were glued to the black and white TV watching the news. At seven years old, I had no idea what was going on and why my mom was crying. All she said was, "President Kennedy was shot." I will always remember that day much like the other days I mentioned and exactly where

As we are celebrating the Feast of Trumpets, we are reminded that the blowing of the trumpet is a memorial, a reminder. Not only is it a memorial, this day of celebration is all about calling *our* awareness to a major event that is in our future.

"For we walk by faith, not by sight."- 2 Corinthians 5:7.

As this event has not yet transpired, we can trust God to bring it to fruition. While we cannot see God right now, we know He is there.

Romans 1:19-20- "Because that which may be known of God is manifest among them, for God has manifested *it* to them; For the invisible things of Him are perceived from *the* creation of *the* world, being understood by the things that were made—both His eternal power and Godhead—so that they are without excuse;"

Psalm 19:1- "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament proclaims His handiwork."

In a world so lost, God has been watered down, excluded, ignored, and filtered out of our lives so much that there is hardly any truth remaining in churches anymore. People would rather be *entertained* on a Sunday morning and hit the buffet and take a nap before the football games start than hear God's real truth. John 20:29- "Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, Thomas, you have believed; *blessed are the ones who have not seen, but have believed.*"

We are walking by faith. Even though we have yet to see Him physically, we have and do feel His presence through His Holy Spirit.

1 John 3:2- "Beloved, now we are the children of God, and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be; but we know that when He is manifested, we shall be like Him, because we shall see Him exactly as He is."

There will come a time when everyone will see, *behold* is a better word, what we long to see now. What we are preparing for now. I was glad to see this week's essay beating the drum with the hole in it too.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18- "But I do not wish you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, that you be not grieved, even as others, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, in exactly the same way also, those who have fallen asleep in Jesus will God bring with Him. For this we say to you by the Word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall in no wise precede those who have fallen asleep Because the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout of command, with the voice of an archangel and with the trumpet of God; and the dead in Christ shall rise first; Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds for the meeting with the Lord in the air; and so shall we always be with the Lord. Therefore, encourage one another with these words."

If we fulfill our commitment to our Lord and are chosen to be in the First Resurrection, we will either rise from our "sleep" our we will be changed in the "twinkling" of an eye. If you overslept for *this* alarm, the snooze button is 1000 years long. Hopefully, our special memory will be one of the two, either the wake-up call or the twinkling change.

1 Corinthians 15:52- "In an instant, *in the twinkling of an eye*, at the last trumpet; for *the* trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed."

When the trumpet actually sounds and Jesus Christ actually returns, it is not going to be a quiet and peaceful event. This day will get everyone, everyone on Planet Earth's attention. He will return, but not exactly as it was told to His disciples by the angels in the Book of Acts.

And *He was* clothed with a garment dipped in blood; and His name is The Word of God. And out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He might smite the nations; and He shall shepherd them with an iron rod; and He treads the winepress of the fury and the wrath of the Almighty God."

Matthew 24:29-31- "But immediately after the tribulation of those days, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken. And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven; and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming upon the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet; and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other."

2 Thessalonians 1:6-10- "Since *it is* righteous with God to recompense tribulation to those who are persecuting you; And to you, who are persecuted, rest with us, at the revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven with His mighty angels, Dealing out vengeance with flaming fire upon those who do not know God, and those who do
